The new PSHE scheme was discussed. Everyone agree they liked the new scheme and were enjoying the lessons. The children reported that they particularly liked the fact that PSHE gave them the opportunity to learn about the outside world, teaching them important life skills for now and the future.

All the children could discuss what topic they had been learning in PSHE and discuss key facts. They knew who they could go to and ask if they, or the parents, had questions about PSHE. They felt comfortable discussing sensitive matters with their peers and teachers but would like to facilitate 'Ask It' baskets in class for times when they wanted to ask something anonymously.

Children liked that PSHE work was collected into a classbook over individual book but reported that getting feedback and understanding if you are doing well in PSHE is difficult. The reps said that this was often because PSHE is opinion and often there isn't a right and wrong answer. They agreed that feedback should continue to be verbal as you can't mark opinions.

One class reported that sometimes in PSHE they found out information they don't like. Miss Ackroyd will remind class teachers about ground rules for PSHE to ensure that children always feel comfortable during these lessons. The children would like more time on PSHE as they felt it was important and one rep said they would like teaching on relationships.

Open forum –
