New lunch routines – school councillors thought that the new lunchtime routines were working really well. They liked having more independence and a choice of food. They also thought that lunchtimes were calmer, less stressful and felt they ended up having slightly longer to play outside.

Indoor shoes/pumps – The children agreed that a lot of learning time was previously lost changing pumps before each lesson. They think that the new system will cause less problems and pumps could still be used when shoes are particularly dirty and for PE lessons.

Assembly – School councillors liked the more modern music being played in assembly and think that the song of the week is a good idea. They said it is too much of a squeeze trying to get everyone in the hall together and thought having assembly on a Monday morning was a good idea.
