Maths planning

- White Rose maths is used for long- and short-term planning
- We are proactive to the needs of individual classes and pupils therefore may supplement White Rose with NCTEM
- Maths is taught daily in all classes with lessons approximately one hour
- KS1 have additional maths lesson 'mastering number' at least 3 times a week.
- Year 3-4 have additional times table lessons, at least 3 times a week.
- Years 3-6 all have weekly arithmetic quizzes

Maths lesson

- Maths mastery approach using the 5 big ideas
- Pupils work in mixed ability groupings
- Manipulatives are displayed and available at all times for <u>all pupils</u>
- Lessons begin with counting then 10 minutes on practising skills using Fluent in Five or Flash back
 Four
- All pupils are expected to use the booklets (with the exception of some SEN). Additional fluency and 'going deeper' to be recorded in blue maths exercise books
- Work is marked with pupils present when ever possible
