Topic: **Let's Celebrate**

Literacy

We will be writing sci-fi stories (fiction) based on Cosmic: One Giant Leap for Boykind and news reports (non-fiction).

Spellings will continue to be sent home on Fridays.

Maths

We will be mastering multiplication and division plus fractions. It is important to practise your times tables — use Times Table Rock Stars as much as possible and we will continue to send a sheet home every Friday.

Topic (Art, DT, History, Geography)

Our topic is 'Let's Celebrate'. In History we will be asking 'Why was the early Islamic civilisation so significant and what impact has it had on modern day Britain?'. We will be looking at timelines (with key dates), Islamic art and the House of Wisdom. Our Art topic this half term will be linked to Humanities and we will be asking the question "How were prints made before machines?"

Science

We will be posing the question: 'How can I explain, demonstrate and compare how properties of materials change?' and investigating the properties of everyday materials. We will create our own Great British Bake Off episodes which show the changing states of matter during baking.

Computing

We will be using the programme Scratch to make computer games with different sounds, characters and challenges. We will also practise typing using Microsoft Word.

We will be doing Outdoor Adventure Activities and Hockey.
