Term: Spring 1

Topic: Can you travel in time?

Literacy

This term we will be looking at the book *The Owl Who Afraid of the Dark* and writing our own stories.

We will use our topic work to learn about *The Great Fire of London* and then write diary entries like Samuel Pepys.

We will continue practising our reading and ensuring we write in full sentences with finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.

Maths

We will be adding and subtracting and learning how to exchange a 10 into 10 ones.

Vocabulary

Numbers 1- 50, addition, add, plus, make, equals, subtraction, subtract, take-away, minus, exchange, crossing 10, how many, finding the difference.

Topic (Art, DT, History, Geography, PSHE)

We will be learning about:

- The Great Fire Of London and the impact it had on London.
- In DT we will be making our own Fire Engines with moving wheels and axles. We will ask your child to bring an empty cereal box please.
- In PSHE we are learning about how to stay safe at home, outside and on the road.
