Topic: Moving on up!

Literacy

We will be reading the story "Trains" and the information book "Little Leaders" linked to our topic work. We will then write our own stories focusing on adjectives, making our sentences longer by using but, and, because and forming letters correctly.

Home Learning: You can help by reading lots of stories at bedtime and encourage children to guess what will happen next.

Maths

Number to 100- one more, one less, measurements and time- o'clock and half past.

Home Learning: You can help by checking what time it is using o'clock and half past.

Topic (Art, DT, Geography, History, PE, RE, Computing)

History: How trains have changed over time.

DT: Sculptures

PE: Athletics on TUESDAYS.

Home Learning: You can help by ensuring children can catch and throw a range of balls/objects.

Home Learning: You can help by identifying the name of wild plants on a walk.

Phonics

Floppy Phonics: We have our phonics screen check test from Monday 5th June. After we will be moving on to alternative sounds which continue in Year 2.

Home Learning: You can help by listening to your child read their book a few times during the week.

Reminders

Homework: In Year 1 your child will bring their book bags home every night and bring back to school every morning. Please encourage your child to read their book a few times during the week. This will make them become fluent in reading.

Maths homework will go home every Friday and brought back to school on Wednesdays.
