Topic: Let's Celebrate

Literacy

We will be writing sci-fi stories (fiction) based on Cosmic: One Giant Leap for Boykind and we will also be writing a newspaper report of a child who accomplishes something growing up (non-fiction)

Maths

We will be mastering multiplication and division plus fractions.
