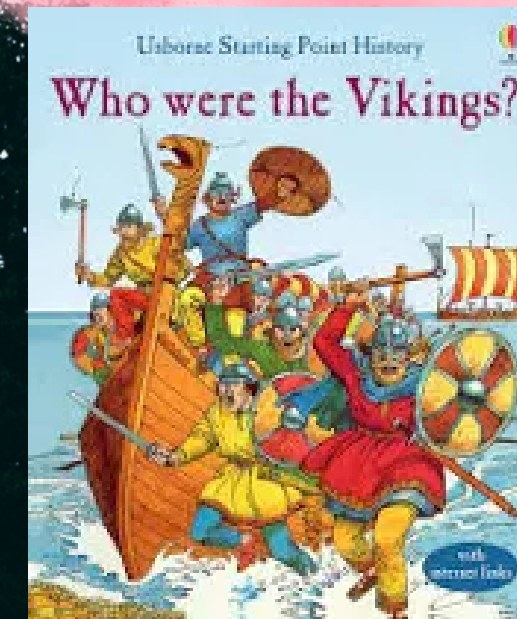

Inwade

To enter a country with a view to conquer the people or plunder the resources.

Raid

A short sudden attack by a small group of people.

Tax

Money paid to the government used to fund public services.

Counties

Areas of the country that are governed by a local authority.

Danegeld

A land tax put in place by the Anglo-Saxons to prevent against invasion.

Wergild

The amount of money an individual's life is worth (from Anglo-Saxon law)
