Kinder transport

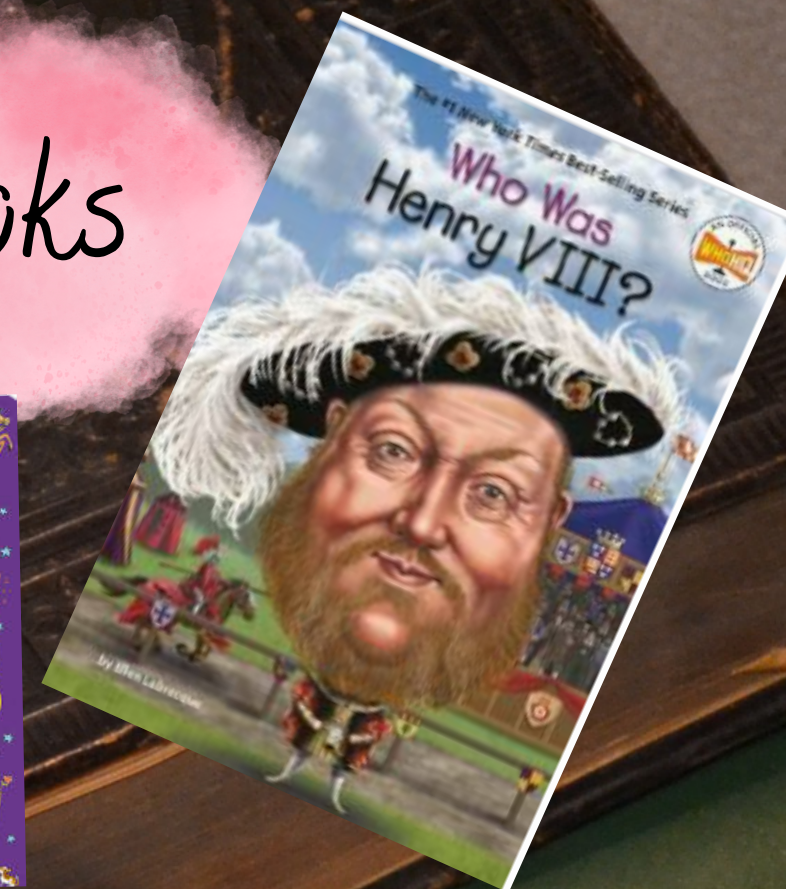
The rescue of mainly Jewish children from Nazi German territory.
